**QWEST CORPORATION'S NOTICE OF FILING REVISED EXHIBIT A TO THE
NINTH REVISED STATEMENT OF GENERALLY AVAILABLE TERMS
AND MOTION FOR APPROVAL**

Qwest Corporation ("Qwest"), through its undersigned counsel, submits this Notice of Filing revised Exhibit A to its Ninth Revised Statement of Generally Available Terms ("SGAT" or "Ninth Revised SGAT") and Motion for Approval.¹ In support, Qwest states as follows:

1. Qwest's Exhibit A has been revised to reflect a slightly different format which includes three columns for notes for each rate element (i.e., recurring, recurring per mile, and non-recurring) in place of the previous single column titled "Notes". These columns now contain the source for all rates as well as provide other necessary or essential detail pertaining to that particular rate. An additional column titled "Recurring, per Mile" has also been inserted between the Recurring and Non-Recurring rate columns to distinguish distance sensitive and non-distance sensitive recurring rates.²

2. Exhibit A has also been revised to include clarifications to certain rate element descriptions as well as some re-sequencing of certain rate elements for ease in locating those

particular elements. These clarifications and re-sequencing of certain rate elements were also reflected in Exhibit A to Qwest's proposed Tenth Revised SGAT noted above.

3. Qwest has eliminated the charges for channel regeneration for DS1 and DS3 loops in Section 8.1.7 of Exhibit A.

4. Qwest has also recalculated the rate for Fiber Transport, per Strand/Mile, Section 9.7.4.1.3, to maintain (or restore) the rate relationship with the Fiber Transport, per Pair rate. This recalculation results in a lower rate for the Fiber Transport, per Strand/Mile element and is being reviewed in Phase II of the cost docket, Docket No. 04M-111T.

5. The rates for Fiber Loop and Termination, Fixed, per Strand/Premise, Sections 9.7.4.2.3 and 9.7.4.2.5 respectively, were inadvertently reversed in the current Exhibit A. Exhibit A has been revised to correct the reversed rates. Additionally, the rate for Fiber Loop, per Strand has been recalculated to restore the rate relationship with Fiber Loop, per Pair resulting in a lower rate per strand. This rate is also being reviewed in Phase II of the cost docket.

6. The rate for UDF - per Pair - Fiber Loop Transport, per Route in Section 9.7.5.3.3 was corrected to match the rate for UDF - Interoffice Facility (IOF) - Single Strand - UDF-Loop Charges - Single Strand - Fiber Loop, per Strand / Route in Section 9.7.4.2.3.


7. Finally, the rate for DS3 Loop Facility, Section 9.23.3.6.3, contains a formatting error and displays "#REF!" instead of the rate. Exhibit A has been revised to reflect the rate.

8. Qwest will provide notice of this filing to Colorado CLECs through its wholesale notification process within five days of the file date and will post the proposed revised Exhibit A to Qwest's website.

WHEREFORE, Qwest requests that the Commission approve the attached revised Exhibit A to its Ninth Revised SGAT, making it effective as expeditiously as possible.


